280 ANN E. LIPSCOMB, Daughter of David Lipscomb (p. 277)

280 (Jan.?) ANN E. LIPSCOMB was b. in Va. 25 Jan. 1799 and died 29 March 1835. (Bible) Married as his second wife, Granville Lipscomb, her cousin. Marriage bond dated 2 Sept, 1828 in Louisa Co. Va. She had two children William and David Lipscomb. They can be found under William, the son of Thomas and Mary Smith Lipscomb, (Four children in this list pp 294-5)

281 NATHAN LIPSCOMB, Son of David Lipscomb (p. 277)

281 NATHAN LIPSCOMB b. 10 June 1801 in Va. (Bible) died in Heard Co. Ga. 2 Jan. 1850. It is said he hung himself from his front porch. He married 1st Elizabeth Beadles, marriage bond dated 29 Aug. 1820, Louisa Co. Va.; bondsman James Beadles. He was married a 2nd time to a lady named "Harriet." He had 14 children. Harriet was probably the mother of most of his children. He was to have been the administrator of his father David Lipscomb's will, but he died before his father did. After Nathan's death Harriet moved to La Grange Ga. He is found as a head of the family for the first time on the Troup Co (later Heard Co.) Census. His age is given as 29, the lady's age as 22. This should rule out Elizabeth Beadles who married Nathan in 1820. This lady's age was given as 32 in (?) 1840; 42 in 1850, and in the 1850 census her name is Harriet. b. in Ga. (See note)

#282 THOMAS LIPSCOMB, Son of David Lipscomb (p.277)

282 THOMAS LIPSCOMB was born in Va. 11 Jan. 1803 (Bible) By the 1830 Census of Troupe Co. Ga. (later Heard Co.) he was there living (no doubt unmarried) with his brother Nathan. He married a native of South Carolina whose name was Jane E. He was living in Heard Co. as late as 1881. (letter he wrote, p.239) He was mentioned in his father, David Lipscomb's will. "As to my son Thomas Lipscomb, who by bad management has wasted a large portion of what I have hertofore advanced to him, it is my will that such portion of my estate as would have fallen to him as on equal division----be retained-or put out on interest and the interest to be paid over to son Thomas annually towards educating the children of son Thomas or supporting the family and and as the children arrive to lawful age or marry an equal portion of the principal I wish to may [sic] be given to each of the children." This probably never happened since Nathan, the exec. of the estate, died before his father David did.

Thomas and his wife Jane had 10 children. On the 1880 census Jane listed her father as being born in South Carolina and her mother as born in Alabama. Nathan listed his occupⁿ"farmer"

#283 MARTHA LIPSCOMB, Daughter of David Lipscomb (p.277)

283 MARTHA LIPSCOMB was born in Louisa Co. Va. 24 June 1805. She was mentioned in David, her father's will. He wrote on 3 March 1847, "As to my unfortunate daughter Martha I will and direct that the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, \$1500, be reserved out of my estate for her support and maintenance---" "I wish her to live with my son Nathan during her or his lifetime." Nathan died 2 Jan. 1850 before his father David died. Malvina Lindsay wrote: "Martha received an injury in childhood from which she never recovered though she lived to moderately old age."

284 MARY LIPSCOMB, Daughter of David Lipscomb (p.277)

284 MARY LIPSCOMB was born in Louisa Co. Va. 27 Feb. 1807 and died there 24 May 1839. She married John T. Chiles 6 June 1831. She probably died giving birth to John Chiles. Her two children Henry and Mary were mentioned in her father's will.

Stephen Pettus deeded Louisa Co., Va. lands to his sons, Dabney, John, and George Pettus. In 1761 in Charlotte Co., Va., John Pettus deeded land to George Terry of Hanover Co., Va., "for love." John Pettus was called "of St. Martin's Parish, Louisa Co.," Va. in a deed in 1754 from his father. This deed was witnessed by Thomas Lipscomb. The 1770 will of Thomas Lipscomb names his daughter, Sarah Pettus. John Pettus was in Charlotte Co., Va. by 1765 and apparently died there that year. 203 JOHN LIPSCOMB, son of Thomas and Sarah (MackGehee) Lipscomb, has been a problem to place timewise. Some have thought that since he was named first in his father's will of 1770, that he must have been the eldest son. But, as pointed out (p. 209), this could have been because the two oldest brothers, William and Thomas, who were named Executors, had probably already received legacies from their father (since there were no specific gifts to them in the will).

He was listed in James Wilkes Lipscomb's 2 Vol. "Lipscomb Genealogy", p.10, (1959) simply, as "B. 1728, married Mary Kimbrough; Ch.- a. Wyatt; b. Phillip, Sr. (married Mary Madison (close relative of President James Madison); c. Robert." The date. 1728, and names of children are to be questioned.

An in-depth study and analysis has been made, and a number of conclusions can be reached, including the deduction that it was his will, dated 1 Jan. 1826, and probated, Louisa Co., 8 Aug. 1830 (Louisa Co. W.B. 8 p.179), naming (no wife); Frances (wife of Dabney Trice; Wyatt; Robert; Waddy; Dianna, wife of George Thompson; and children of his two deceased daughters, - Susan, wife of Wm. Beadles, and Sally, wife of Reuben Vest.

It will be noticed that Philip does not appear in this list, and no connection between Philp and this John has been found. (See p. 55)

John Lipscomb had inherited, in his father's will of 1770, 500 acres on Goldmine Creek, Louisa Co.. His first published record is the 1777 Louisa Co. Tithe list on which John is shown with 4 tithes, probably himself and 3 slaves. ("History of Louisa Co." - Malcolm H. Harris, p.170).

It is very probable that John did marry Mary Kimbrough about 1770-5. deduced from recorded and estimated birth dates of their children. In addition to the Louisa Co. data, Cathrine C. Mann has furnished data on their sons, Wyatt, and Robert who went to So. Carolina. Wyatt's birth had been set at 7 Feb. 1777, Louisa Co., and he was apparently the oldest child. Others were born up thru 1790.

Much research has been conducted, especially by Jacoue Anderson (Mrs. Dan, Rhodes Mich.) on the Kimbrough family, for data on Mary. Mary Kimbrough was the daughter of Wm. Kimbrough (who d. 1765) and his wife, Sarah Fields. After her husband's death, Sarah married (2) John Moss of Louisa Co. who died by 1796. Sarah Moss made her will 30 July 1800, prob. 13 Oct. 1800 (Lou. Co. W.B. 4 p.133) leaving a legacy to her daughter, Mary Lipscomb.

So, Mary Kimbrough was born sometime before 1765, and it is reasonable to estimate that John Lipscomb would have been born ca. 1750-55, and that they married, as mentioned above, ca. 1770-75, which would call for Mary's birth to have been ca. 1755-60 (?). We assume that she had died before 1826.

The "Douglas Register" indicates their marriage as 26 Apr. 1782, because Rev. Douglas, when he did not know the actual marriage date, used the date of the birth of the first child of the couple for whom he performed the baptism. In this case, the first was Jo: Lipscomb (could be John or Joseph), 26 Apr. 1782. He recorded another child for the couple, -- Diannah Lipscomb. b. 17 Oct. 1784. She was very probably named for Mary's sister, Dianna.

No military service record has been found for John Lipscomb, but he did fur-

nish supplies for the Colonist forces, as indicated in Public Service Claims,-

John Lipscomb, Louisa Co. Court Booklet p.5,6,34; Certificates 3; List I p.1,26,27; Commissioner's Book III p.337 & 358(?)

Land Tax records do not reveal much. John had disposed of at least half of his inherited 500 acres on Goldmine Cr. by first tax assessment in 1782, when he showed 246 acres, increased to 257 $\frac{3}{4}$ in 1803 through 1816, then 250 acres through 1822 (as far as checked). His son, Wyatt acquired 170 acres in 1806, and held varying quantities through 1822, at least, though he had gone to S. Carolina by 1820. Waddy began taxes 1816, and remained in Louisa Co. Son, Robert paid Personal Property tax only one year- 1810, and had gone to S. Carolina sometime before 1830. Since there are no further records for a son, John (or. Joseph), it is assumed that he may have died young.

A death date for John Lipscomb has not been determined, but further research after 1822 in Louisa Co. Land taxes, might reveal when he no longer paid tax. But, his will, dated 1 Jan.1826 was probated 8 Aug. 1830 (Louisa Co. W.B. 8, p.179), so he had died meanwhile. His wife, Mary, had died earlier, before 1820, since his 1820 Louisa Co. Census, p 55 shows only himself, ae. over 45, and having 9 slaves, listing 5 in agriculture.

He was taxed in Louisa Co. through at least 1822, but he had gone to S. Carolina by 1820, when he is listed in Spartansburg District p. 263 with no females and with 2 males 26-45 (possibly himself and brother, Robert?).

Mrs. Mann reports,--

"b. 7 Feb. 1777, Louisa Co., Va.; died 16 May 1830, York District, S.C.; will dated 3 Feb. 1830, probated 7 June 1830, recorded in Will Book 6, page 320, York Co., S.C. Mentions wife, Hannah Lipscomb; children of Eliza Jeffries late Eliza Green; children of Louisa Jeffries, late Louisa Green; bond given Daniel Smith, Esquire as trustee for Eliza & Louisa; brother Waddy Lipscomb now living in Va.; brother, Robert Lipscomb of Spartansburg District, S.C.; Col. James Jeffries of Union District, S.C. named to be guardian for children of Eliza Jeffries; Wm. Jeffries of Union District to be guardian for children of Louisa Jeffries. Daniel Smith, Esqr. of York Dist., S.C. and Smith Lipscomb, Sr. of Spartansburg and brother, Robert Lipscomb, Executors. Witnesses: James Wood, Thos. Bridges, Polly Wood.

Wyatt Lipscomb is buried at Buffalo Baptist Church near Blacksburg, S.C."

It would seem that Wyatt married late, - after 1820, and had no children of his own. Identity of the Jeffries families has not been made.

DESCENDANTS OF JOHN and DINAH (MACKGEEHEE) LIPSCOMB (See p.21)16 ANDERSON LIPSCOMB, Son of John and Dinah Lipscomb

16 ANDERSON LIPSCOMB, son of John and Dinah (MackGehee) Lipscomb, would have been born probably ca. 1725. He was the first of four Lipscombs in this branch who were named Anderson, - which raises a question as to the origin of the name-- not a typical Lipscomb name. Frequently a surname used as a given name signified that it was the surname of the mother, but, this did not seem to be the case,-- unless possibly, Dinah's mother had been an Anderson.

The only tangible Anderson connection, so far presented, is that Thomas MackGehee had two neighbors, named Anderson to the west, -- an Alexander Anderson patented 100 acres, 2 Nov.1705 (Pat. B.9 p.702-3); and the name David Anderson is mentioned as a boundary for an earlier patent of Wm. Andrews for 100 acres, 23 Oct.1702 (Pat.B.4 p.432).

Anderson Lipscomb was married possibly ca. 1745,-(3 of his sons were Officers in the Revolutionary War, probably born before 1750). The name of his wife is unknown, but she apparently was living at the time of his death. Extant documents (K.Wm.B.II p. 37-40,& 41-46) dealing with the final settlement of his estate by his son, Capt. Bernard Lipscomb, in 1785, would indicate that he had left a will, dated July __1773 leaving land for his wife's use, to be sold at her death, at Public Auction, and mentioning land left to his son, John. His son, Reuben was to be the Executor, but he died in the War, so Bernard settled the estate.

Bernard put the land, 350 acres, up for auction, and his brother, Ensign Thomas Lipscomb bought it. These documents are severely damaged, but it appears that Bernard, then, bought half of it from Thomas. This land was bound by Drury Ragsdale's land and Wm. Hollins', and was, it would seem adjacent, west of the site of St. John's Parish Church. It was the nucleus of Capt. Bernard Lipscomb's later land holdings. These transactions took place on Dec. 10 and 15, 1785. (See Barnard's deed to Thomas, p.363)

An adjoining portion called "Tandy's" was not included in these transactions, because it had been "lent" to Anderson's son, John. The identity of this son, John, and the outcome of that land has not been found as yet, except for some illusive references to Tandy's Spring in later deeds involving a Robert Lipscomb (who just may have been a son of that John.) (See p. 361)

It is interesting to speculate on the means by which Anderson Lipscomb had accumulated so much land, - land that was not originally Lipscomb, --- had it come to him by inheritance from his wife's family?

In addition, he must have been caught up with "westward expansion", since a deed 18 May 1762 (Goochland Co. D.B.8 p 249) shows that Anderson Lipscomb of King Wm. Co bought from Wm. Neaves, for £50, 294 acres in Goochland Co. adjacent to Major Powers, Nath'l West Dandridge, Henry Adkins and John Lewis. This land was later involved with a swap with his brother Daniel who sold it, 16 Mar.1767 (G.D.B.9 p.87) to John King of Goochland Co.

A brief reference in Caroline County Order Books (all other books destroyed)

11 July 1767 (Car.Co. O.B.1767-70 p.42) indicates a suit, by Anderson, which was "abated by the plaintiff's death".

Anderson Lipscomb died, then, sometime after the date of his will, and before 1781, a date mentioned on p. 42. His children were apparently,--

(p. 349)

373 REUBEN LIPSCOMB, perhaps the eldest son of Anderson Lipscomb, would have been born ca. 1750 (?) in King William County. He apparently did not marry, and he left few records, except Military ones.

"Historical Register of Virginians in the Revolution... 1775-1783" - John H. Gwathney (1938) and "Historical Register of Officers of the Continental Army" - B.F. Heitman (1893) p. 265, show him as 1st Lieut. 7th Va. Reg't, 26 Feb. 1776; Captain 28 Nov. 1776; transferred to 5th Va. Reg't 14 Sept. 1778; died 3 Oct. 1778. "Records of the Revolutionary War" - W.T.R. Saffell (1858) adds that he "died in the service Oct. 3, 1778. His heirs received 4,000 acres of land from the State."

A brief reference is made to a Capt. Lipscomb, most likely Capt. Reuben, in "State Records of North Carolina" Vol. 12 p 501. At Headquarters, Paramus, 12 July 1777 was given the report of a Court Martial held 9 July 1778 in which Capt. Lipscomb was tried "for treating the Genl. in a Disrespectful manner". He had taken "Quarters in a house destined for the Genl. Commanding the Division", - Gen'l Baron Von Stuben. The Court, unanimously decreed him not guilty, and acquitted him with Honor, approved by the General, himself who agreed that no disrespect had been meant.

There seems to be no record of his death,-- Saffell merely says "in service".

Capt. Reuben Lipscomb had written his will 28 Apr., 1778. He died 3 Oct. 1778. We are indebted to "Virginia Soldiers of 1776" Vol. 3 pp. 1223-5 for further information as to his will, and also the inheritance of his Bounty Lands. It quotes - p. 1224 -- in abstract, (the will no longer extant)

"...last will and testament. To my sister Mariah Lipscomb; my nephew Robert Lipscomb; my niece Mary Lipscomb; to Nath'l Fox's daughter Ann Fox; to Henry, son of Nathaniel Fox; my brother Bernard Lipscomb all the remaining part of my estate, real and personal. He appointed as his Extrs. John Fox, Jr. and his brother Bernard Lipscomb. Witnesses William Boswell, Charles Lipscomb and Nath'l Fox. Copy of will filed in office of King William Co.

Court, May 1779, the record of which has been destroyed by fire. Teste, Ro. Pollard, Clerk." Formally proved in Court 19 Apr. 1781.

"Sister Mariah" remains a mystery. Was she actually a sister, or could she have been a widow of the equally mysterious brother, John? (oftentimes a sister-in-law was called sister). "Nephew Robert, and Niece Mary Lipscomb could, in light of later tangled documents, have been possibly children of his brother, John. His brother, Ensign Thomas Lipscomb, was not mentioned at all, -- odd!

Nathaniel Fox, father of the Ann and Henry Fox mentioned, was probably the Lt. Nath'l Fox of King William County, son of Thos. and Mary (Tunstall) Fox of King William Co.. This Nath'l Fox married, ca. 1770 Sally Russell, daughter of John and Jane Russell. In-depth study has been made into Fox family history, and, so far, no family ties have been found. Was this just a favorite neighborhood family?

Capt. Reuben Lipscomb's Bounty Land went to his brother, Capt. Bernard. In 1837, lengthy records, described in "Virginia Soldiers of 1776" by Burgess, (above) describe the claim by the heirs of Capt. Bernard, for the division of the "additional pay" for the services on file, for their uncle Reuben.

374 CAPT. BERNARD LIPSCOMB, Son of Anderson (p. 349)

374 BERNARD LIPSCOMB, son of Anderson Lipscomb, would have been born probably ca. 1755 (since his Obituary, 1823, gave his age as 68, - though the list of Volunteers in 1812 quoted him as aged 53!). He married before, or during the Revolutionary War, Mary Hill, daughter of James and Mildred (Clopton) Hill.

Bernard Lipscomb was a Captain Lieutenant of Artillery, 1778 until March 1782. The one Military slip in the National Archives, for him, is dated 4 Feb. 1781, from the Auditor's Office listing him, as such, as an "officer of the Regiment of Artillery, raised for the defence of the Commonwealth of Virginia, under the command of Col. Thomas Marshall," in "Edmond's Command."

For his three years of service, as captain, he was awarded 4,000 acres, in Kentucky, 12-31-'82 on Warrant #80 ("Catalogue of Revolutionary Soldiers and Sailors of the Commonwealth of Virginia to whom Land Bounty Warrants were granted by Virginia for Military Services in the War for Independence" - Sam'l M. Wilson, Ky. (1952) p.44-48). 1,000 acres of this, he and his wife sold, 9 Dec. 1808, to Tunstall Quarles (Adair Co., Ky. D.B. "B" p 230).

Capt. Bernard Lipscomb must have been a highly respected citizen in the community, having been called upon to witness documents, and appointed to settle problems, both family and neighborhood. He acted as Executor for his father's will, his brother, Reuben, having died. He handled (apparently) the sale of the land his brother, Thomas, had secured from his father's lands, selling it first to Thos. P. Madison who defaulted, then, 26 Jan. 1794, to Peter Bowden. (K.Wm. B.III p.49-50). (See p. 349 and p. 369)

In 1789 Alterations, Bernard Lipscomb had deeded to Wm. Degge 142 acres. On 21 Mar. 1795, Wm. Degge and Bernard Lipscomb deeded to Robert Lipscomb, for \$115, a tract in St. John's Parish, 142 acres, including "Tandy's Spring" (Was this "the place called 'Tandy's'" in Anderson's lands, lent to his son, John? And, was Robert a son of John, and the nephew of Reuben?)

In 1796. (26 Dec.) (K.Wm.B.III p.218), Bernard is recorded as having become security on 7 Feb. 1795 for payment by Robert to James Johnson, Jr.

Capt. Bernard Lipscomb's Land tax record 1782-3 was for 476 acres, and for varying quantities all through to 595 acres, 1811-1823 when he died, -"8 miles E. of Court House, near Lower Church." His Personal Property tax usually included a "chair" or a "coach", and sometimes as many as 11 to 15 slaves.

In 1812, he volunteered, in King William County, as being willing to serve, if needed, against the British (21T126)- aged 53-(did he "fudge" a little?). Bernard and Mary Lipscomb are listed as having joined the Colosse Baptist Church in 1813.

Bernard Lipscomb's Obituary 6 Sept. 1823 was published in "The Family Visitor" (Richmond, Va. 1822-26) (68V p.76) saying that he died at age 68, "a hero of the Revolution". He had also furnished supplies during the Revolutionary War.

His will, dated 22 July 1819, was probated 22 Oct. 1833. He left his lands - the plantation to his wife, Mary, during her lifetime; to son, Reuben, land purchased from Wm. Langhorne; to son, James Hill Lipscomb, the plantation on which he then lived; and confirmed the gift of 1,000 acres in Kentucky to his daughter, Harriet. Others mentioned were daughters - Mildred H. Lipscomb, Louisa Winfree & Minerva Mitchell. So, from this abstract (as in Burgess, Vol. 3 p.1225) and from the deposition p 1223-4, we glean the following list of the children of Capt. Bernard and Mary (Hill) Lipscomb. (also, the article by Mrs. Herbert Lipscomb, Richmond, Va. in Burgess p.768, Vol.2)

- 380 JAMES HILL LIPSCOMB (sometimes, just "Hill"), born ca. 1790; married (1) 3 Feb. 1820, Maria Sterling; to Sumter Co. Ala. ca. 1835, m., there (2) Frances Lipscomb, widow of James; died 1844. An Extr. in father's will. (See p. 356)
- 381 LOUISA LIPSCOMB, born ca. 1792(?); married Obediah Winfree, lived in Richmond. (See p. 357)
- 382 MINERVA LIPSCOMB, born in 1790s (?); married Thomas B. Mitchell, King William Co. (See p. 358)
- 383 MILDRED LIPSCOMB, born ca. 1800 (was 30-40/1830 Census); married (1) Wm. F. Clone (as listed in various sources - but, it might well be Wm. F. Olonne whose K.Wm. Tax records show that he had died ca. 1816, in the near vicinity.), married (2) Austin Lipscomb, b. 1790, son of Daniel and Jane Lipscomb. (See p. 358)

The outline of this branch of the Lipscomb family has been organized by the compiler from materials and data sent by different descendants (noted in their portions), in addition to data collected from Census and other records.

378 REUBEN LIPSCOMB, Son of Capt. Bernard and Mary (Hill) Lipscomb

378 REUBEN LIPSCOMB, son of Capt. Bernard and Mary (Hill) Lipscomb, was born, according to family records, 11 Feb. 1780, and was surely named for his uncle, Capt. Reuben Lipscomb. He married, 29 July 1817, Ann Morgan Ellett (b. 2 Dec. 1790, and sister of Temple Ellett, according to some records). One account says that Reuben had married previously, but that his wife and first son had both died.

Reuben and Ann left King William Co. for Richmond about 1835, when he is supposed to have bought the "handsome old mansion occupying the square bounded by Marshall and Clay and 29th and 30th Streets, but then outside the city." He died in Richmond, 11 Aug. 1842, and Ann died 1857.

Reuben was a soldier in the War of 1812. His widow petitioned, 5 Apr. 1855, from her residence in Hanover Co., for a pension based on her husband's service. The Auditor's office showed that Reuben had "served as Lieut. in Capt. Wm. L Abraham's Co., Va. Ma. from 5 to 21 Dec. 1814, and was paid for 17 days." (Nat'l Archives) In her declaration, she stated that she was married to said Reuben Lipscombe in the County of Hanover by Parson Talley on the 29th day of July 1817. (The Hanover people did insist on the "e" on the end!)

Reuben had died, but Ann's entry on the 1850 Census of Richmond, Va. (in Henrico Co.), shows that they had possibly had only two children, P.470, line 34-

379 HARRIET LIPSCOMB, daughter of Capt. Bernard and Mary (Hill) Lipscomb, was born probably in the 1780s, in King William Co., Va.. We are indebted to the section on the settlement of inheritance claim on Capt. Reuben Lipscomb's Land Warrants, as issued to his heirs, in Richmond Hustings Court, 12 Sept. 1837, -- as reported in Burgess "Virginia Soldiers of 1776", p. 1223-4, - for a listing of the children of Capt. Bernard Lipscomb. This listing was included in a deposition made by Francis West Quarles, husband of Mary Ann Lipscomb, daughter of this Harriet Lipscomb.

According to the above reference, Harriet Lipscomb had married (1) John Meredith, and, after his death (date?), had married (2) "John Lipscomb of the City of Richmond" (date?). Could that John have possibly been the son of Pemberton and Lucy Lipscomb (p. 425) ?

Before the 1837 date, above, Harriet had died, leaving three children-- by her first or second husband? The deposition abstract merely lists "Sarah (mar. Thomas Gardner of Hanover Co.)", but does list Mary Ann Lipscomb and Lucy Lipscomb, so they, at least must have been daughters of the second husband, John Lipscomb.

380 JAMES HILL LIPSCOMB, (sometimes called "Hill"), the second son of Capt. Bernard and Mary (Hill) Lipscomb was born, according to some early family records, in 1782, but his apparently ONLY census record, K. Wm. Co., 1830 would indicate birth between 1790 and 1800.

One possible marriage record seems to fit, -- 13T190-1 quotes a Bible record in the Vaughn Family of Gloucester Co., VA - indicating that Maria Sterling (b. 3 July 1803, dau. of Joseph Cluverius Sterling and Anne, his wife) had married James Hill Lipscomb, 3 Feb. 1820.

His 1830 Census record, King William Co., p. 71, line 26, shows, --

So, had Maria, his first wife, died, leaving him with three young daughters,

of whom we have no record?

James Hill Lipscomb and his brother, Reuben, were named by their father in his will of 1819, as Executors. Capt. Bernard Lipscomb died 1823, and his tax listing is marked "Est." in 1824 and 1825. Then, in 1826, according to the Tax list margin, James Hill Lipscomb had inherited 482 acres of his father's 595 acres, by his will, adj. the Lower Church and John P. Richeson.

James Hill Lipscomb may have spent some time in Henrico Co., probably Richmond, though we have found no records there. He finally went to Sumter Co., Alabama by around 1835. There, he seems to have married Frances Lipscomb, (Daughter of Lt. Yancey Lipscomb), whose husband, oddly enough also a James Lipscomb, had died some years previously (See p. 376) This is evidenced by the two documents in K. Wm. Co. Record Books (B.9 p.409-10) relinquishing Frances' dower rights in his sale of land to Thos. T. Neale,-- and (B.9-p. 414), dower rights in sale of land to Thos. B. Mitchell (husband of his sister, Minerva). These lands seem to be all or part of the land he had inherited from his father in K. Wm. Co. These documents were dated 28 Feb. 1837. A later document, 31 Aug. 1837, appointed Herbert Claiborne his power of Attorney (from Gaines Mills, Sumter Co., Ala.) apparently in the matter of the lands in the settlement of the Warrants of Capt. Reuben Lipscomb (p. 356)

No 1840 Census has been found for him, nor has a will been found, but one reference indicates that he died in 1844 or 1845, possibly in Greene Co., Ala.. Also, no records have been found of his three daughters by his first wife. His widow, Frances, survived him by a number of years.

381 LOUISA LIPSCOMB, Daughter of Capt. Bernard Lipscomb (p.351)

381 LOUISA LIPSCOMB, daughter of Capt. Bernard and Mary (Hill) Lipscomb, was born probably in late 1790s, King William Co.. She married, ca. 1818 (?) Obediah Winfree, who died before 1840. They lived in Richmond, VA.

Louisa's death date is not known, but in the 1850 Census, she is shown, living with a daughter, -- Henrico Co. Census p. 325, line 2 --

382 MINERVA LIPSCOMB, a daughter of Capt. Bernard and Mary (Hill) Lipscomb, was born probably shortly after 1800. She married by ca. 1819, Thomas B. Mitchell and they lived in K. Wm. Co., where he acquired 113 acres (from James Hill Lipscomb?) from the 595 acres of Minerva's father's, and added 150 acres purchased from Alex Frazer.

383 MILDRED LIPSCOMB, Daughter of Capt. Bernard Lipscomb (p.351)

383 MILDRED LIPSCOMB, one of the youngest of the daughters of Capt. Bernard and Mary (Hill) Lipscomb, was born in the 1790s, King William Co.. She is thought to have married (1) a Wm. F. Clone, as reported in several sources. However, since there seems to have been no record of any Wm. F. Clone, it seems quite probable that this has, somehow, been misread by early researchers, and that she did marry a Wm. F. Olonne who had numerous records.

Wm. F. Olonne's Personal Tax began 1810 with 1 white tithe and 1 horse. In 1811, he bought 328 acres adjoining Daniel Lipscomb's (S.of Geo. Major) widow, Jane, also adjoining Alvey, on main road to Frazer's Ferry (K.Wm.B 6 p. 87). To this he added other lands, accumulating 383 acres 9/-, by 1813. But, his 1814 Tax is shown as "Est", adj. John Mill & Wm. Gregory, so he had died young.

If he did marry Mildred Lipscomb, daughter of his near neighbor, Capt. Bernard Lipscomb, it was a short marriage, and whether or not, they had children is not known, tho' the later Census records might indicate the possibility. Mildred married (2) Austin Lipscomb, son of Daniel and Jane (p. 408)

One point of interest appears on the 1819 Land Tax listing, when Austin Lipscomb paid the tax on the otherwise-listed Wm. F. Olonne "Est" 383 acres. So, was it possibly about that time when Mildred married Austin Lipscomb?, - confirmed by the 1820 K. Wm. Co. Census, p. 301 --

375 THOMAS LIPSCOMB, apparent son of Anderson Lipscomb, was born ca. 1757. He was listed in the volunteers of 1812 as being age 55. He evidently did not marry.

His military records show him commissioned, 28 Nov. 1776. (An Ensign in the British Infantry until 1871 and in the Continental Army is defined as a commissioned officer of grade now known as sublieutenant: the officer who carries the colors). His file in the National Archives contains 25 slips, mostly pay slips during his term of duty in the 7th Regiment, in Capt. Reuben Lipscomb's Company commanded by Col. Alexander McClenahan, or sometimes by Col. Holt Richeson (of King William Co.). One of the last slips shows that he resigned from service 20 May 1778, still in his brother's Company. (p.402)

He received his own balance of pay, -- 164-8-0, on 13 June 1783. His Bounty Land award was for 2666 2/3 acres, as due an Ensign for 3 years service, #s 5505, 5506, 5507, and 5508, 31 Dec. 1782 ("Revolutionary War Records. Virginia" Vol. I-G.M. Brumbaugh (1936) p.103).

Part of these Warrants, he turned over to Wm. Bird, Jr. as his atty. to collect for him. Wm. Bird, Jr. died, -- and this all led to a heap of trouble in 1808, with a complicated amount of litigation, described in "Virginia Soldiers of 1776" - Burgess, Vol. II p. 772-776. It does seem odd that this article would say, p. 772, that Thomas Lipscomb had died 1799, in Spotsylvania Co., and that he had married, 1755, Mary Smith, and give names of the children, etc. --- and, then go on to describe this lengthy legal activity re: his Bounty Lands, and even quote in the last paragraph, the Power of Attorney which Ensign Thomas signed on 24 June 1808, in King William County.

"Historical Register of Officers of the Continental Army during the War of the Revolution, April 1775 to December 1783" - Francis B. Heitman (1914) p.352. makes the same mistake in quoting his death as 1799. Many descendants have been confused by this - descendants of the Thomas Lipscomb of Spotsylvania, and have called their ancestor "Thomas Lipscomb, Ensign". The mistaken assumption is made also in "Va. Soldiers of 1776" pp769-772. This distinction must be emphasized, -- the Thomas Lipscomb of Spotsylvania was born (family tradition) 25 Mar. 1737, and was son of Thomas and Sarah (MackGehee) Lipscomb of Louisa Co.. He married Mary Smith 18 Oct. 1759, lived in Spotsylvania (complete tax records, there, through at least 1817). He died at son's, Louisa Co., 12 June 1825 (family records). Two of his many children went South with their uncle William Lipscomb after the Revolutionary War. - Joel and Nathan. (See p. 237 for Thomas Lipscomb of Spotsylvania)

Thomas, of Spotsylvania Co., was on a list of "The Militia of Spotsylvania County, Virginia, as evidenced by petitions of November 14, 1776" (The Genealogical Dept., DAR Magazine 1947-1959" Compiled by Esker, p.523) He also furnished supplies during the War. (DAR acceptance).

Thomas, Ensign, of King William County, stayed in the County, and apparently did not marry (at least, no records to show it). He did have the complicated litigation, in 1807-8. indicating his residence in King William Co.. And, on three separate occasions, he, as Ensign, gave affidavits confirming service of his fellow soldiers and officers, in order for them or their heirs to receive their benefits, -- these affidavits indicate residence in K. Wm. Co.

3 Dec. 1809 - Nath'l Fox (dec'd) of King William Co., 7th Va. Reg't, as Second Lieut., three years.

- 22 Jan.1810 - David L. Smith, confirming certificate of his service, for his widow's pension application.
- 5 Mar.1814 - George Thompson, as Orderly Sargeant. in Continental Army under Holt Richeson, 7th Va. Reg't, Commanded by Col. Alexander McClanahan, three years.

(See National Archives full files for these above men.) (and see "Virginia Soldiers of 1776" - Burgess, Vol.III p 1160 for Mrs. H.E. Lipscomb's correction of the identity of the two Thomas Lipscombs).

The land records of Thomas Lipscomb (Ensign) in King Willlam County were brief. in 1785 and 1787, he was taxed for 168 acres, no doubt the "175 acres" in the division of their father's land, with his brother Bernard. 1789 Alterations show the 168 acres 7/4 deeded by Thomas to Thomas P. Madison. (see p.351) (See also p. 349 and p. 363)

From then on, Thomas Lipscomb shows no land record. His Personal Property Tax shows him as Thomas "Sr", beginning 1800, evidently to distinguish him on records, from the younger Thomas, brother of Archibald (when the younger Thomas and his brother left for North Carolina, ca. 1804, his listing became merely Thomas. on through at least 1811 (as far as checked)).

The last record we have of him, as of now, is the 1814 (Mar.4) affadavit, above. Since he does not show on the 1820 Census of King William County. it is to be wondered if he had died. Personal Property Tax should really be checked further, after 1811, he could have been living with relatives.

No evidence that he married and had children.

376 JOHN LIPSCOMB, Son of Anderson Lipscomb (p. 349)

376 JOHN LIPSCOMB, son of Anderson Lipscomb, remains a puzzle. He is actually only known as a son because of the damaged documents dealing with the settlement of his father's estate in 1785. He would have been born probably ca.1750-60. He had married, probably before 1773 (July) when, according to the settlement documents, (K.Wm.B.II p.41-45, 1785), the sale of the portion of the estate "land called Tandys" "claimed by the representatives of John Lipscomb -- under a Marriage Promise" was to be left to the determination of the Court. No further records regarding the specific disposition have been found.

But, can the "Land called Tandys" provide a clue? Refer to p. 349. Had the 142 acres which Bernard Lipscomb deeded to Wm. Degge (1789 Alterations) been this land, which perhaps Bernard had ultimately received? This 142 acres, then, Wm Degge and Bernard Lipscomb, both, sold, 21 Mar.1795, to Robert Lipscomb for £115,-in the description of the land, included "Tandys Spring", and apparently adjoining, or very near Bernard's own lands.

Could this Robert Lipscomb have been the "Nephew" in Capt. Reuben Lipscomb's will of 1778,-- and thus possibly the son of the mysterious John, brother of Reuben and Bernard? If "Tandys" had belonged to his father, John, then, why would Bernard have sold it to Robert?

It does seem very likely that John, son of Anderson Lipscomb, may have had these children -- (John's death. before (?) 1773)

- 384 ROBERT LIPSCOMB, born ca. 1770 (?); married (?) Elizabeth Quarles; died (?) by 1798
- 385 MARY LIPSCOMB, (mentioned as niece- along with nephew, Robert,- in Capt. Reuben's will of 1778.) No statistics.

384 ROBERT LIPSCOMB, possible son of John Lipscomb(p.360)

384 ROBERT LIPSCOMB, possible son of John Lipscomb, would have been born possibly ca. 1770 (?). Clues point to the probability that he married, ca.(?)1790, Elizabeth (?) Quarles, though there is no definite proof.

As indicated above, Robert bought, 21 Mar.1795, the 142 acres from Bernard Lipscomb and Wm. Degge. No connection with the family of Degge has been found (except the marriage of his daughter, Elizabeth, to John Lipscomb, and they went to live in Washington). (that John,-the son of Philip and Mary (Madison) Lipscomb (see p. 61).

Robert, and Elizabeth, his wife, sold the 142 acres, in short time, on 28 Sept.1795 to Archibald Lipscomb for £142-10-0-.a little profit!

Then, on 26 July, 1796, in a sort of Mortgage, Robert "sells" to Bernard Lipscomb goods, chattels, slaves, horses, cattle, furniture and 1/6 part of the estate of Wm. Neale dec'd, (decreed to Robert Lipscomb by Court of King William). This involved the agreement in which Bernard, on 7 Feb. 1795, became security for payment of £92-0-8 payable on 1 Jan.1796 to James Johnson, Jr.. This "deed" was to become void if the payment was paid. James Johnson, Jr., it seems, was the administrator of the estate of Wm. Neale. The deed was proved 26 Dec.1796, so the payment must not have been made.

A possible connection with the Neale family has not been determined. Wm. Neale seems to have left a considerable estate. Could Robert's mother (wife of John), have been an heir? Or, could Elizabeth, wife of Robert have been an heir, or even possibly a widow of an heir (perhaps the daughter of Wm. Neale who supposedly married James Quarles) ?

Robert was taxed, Personal Property only, in King William County in only 1791 and 1795 for his one titheable, 6 bl. over 16, 1 over 12 & 2 horses. In 1796, it was for only 3 bl. over 16, others, same.

Did Robert Lipscomb die, by 1798? His wife, Elizabeth Q.Lipscomb, shows on Personal Property Tax list, 1798,- no titheable, 3 bl. over 16, 1 over 12 and 0 horses. In Apr.1799, Elizabeth Q. Lipscomb deeded (K. Wm.BIII-p.372) to Ambrose Edwards, £94, land inherited from Wm. Neale. This land was west of the Court House. There are no further records for her, as Elizabeth Q. Lipscomb,-- did she marry again?

Had Robert and Elizabeth Q. Lipscomb had any children?
